









Residents of a jurisdiction represented by an elected official are called "constituents," and the constituents who choose to cast a ballot for their chosen candidate are called "voters."


As per the Indian Constitution, all Indian citizens above the age of 18 years who have registered themselves as voters are eligible to vote. These individuals can vote in national, state, district as well as local government body elections.

The Election Commission of India was established to oversee the election process and guarantee that it ran smoothly. The Election Commission is in charge of everything relating to elections, including election supervision, control, and direction, as well as election conduct. A detailed description about the voting rights and elections is given in Part XV Article 324 – 329 of the Constitution of India.


