





Change Brings Change was a fun club service activity which was also linked with learning and realizing the most basic and important thing that brings us pride and uniqueness of being Indians.



A session in collaboration with the Rotaract Club of Swarna, Bangalore was completed on the 30th of January, 2022.


The session was a very interesting and informative one which enlightened the gathering about the ayurvedic science of pediatrics.




PAWS FOR THE CAUSE
