
They were:




Like every year, this vibrant event took place successfully with participation in large number.



On reaching the "GONE MAD" factory of GARUDA POLYFLEX FOOD PVT LTD, there was a presentation which included a brief introduction to the company and their operations concerning the popular Choco-Stick Gone Mad, it was a learning experience where we got to know about process of manufacturing the chocolate, the safety measures adopted by the company in the process and the sources of the raw materials and other necessary products.

We were also given an opportunity to make queries where we learnt about their inventory management, cost structure and the strategies implemented. Then we proceeded to the factory to view the production process where we could see the various machinery used in the process, we could also witness the whole process which includes the packing and treatment of waste from the process. At the end of this session we received free samples of their products.

Then we left for PRAKASH COACH BUILDERS PVT LTD located in PEENYA INDUSTRIAL AREA BANGALORE.

On reaching the place we were divided into two groups and received an introduction about "PRAKASH COACH BUILDERS" various branches and the Peenya branch that we visited exclusively works on the interiors of the coaches and its exterior painting. We were also told that they manufacture buses on tender basis for various state governments. We then proceeded to the manufacturing premises to view their operations, we could check on the interiors of the bus, their new designs. They addressed our queries regarding the cost and profit aspects in the transport sectors.



At the end of this visit, we gained a combined knowledge about both the theory and practical aspects of an industry, this visit also gave us a good opportunity to gain awareness about the technological developments and the industrial practices.

E-Certificates were given to all registered participants. Participants have expressed their appreciations for the informative and content filled session.


Adding value to your career by obtaining a prestigious and professional qualification by HOCK


Department of commerce has organised National Webinar on "CAMPUS TO CAREER" on 13th June 2020.



The webinar conveners were, Prof Indu Y and Assistant Prof - Sindhu Prabhakaran.


The 3 Failures


over 17 years of experience in the field of higher education, presently she is working as the Regional Manager South Asia in the University of Western Australia, she is also a proud alumni of our College.






Role of NGOs in Society Building


The Inter-collegiate webinar had a good response with 35 participants who were both students and faculty members of different colleges and organizations.



The resource person for the webinar was Vidhushi. Sindhu Bhairavi, Assistant Professor, MES College of Arts, Commerce and Science.


The webinar began at 4.00 p.m. and went up to 5.30 p.m. 27 participants attended the webinar.

This covered topics like:


- Basics of Communication
