## **RESPONSES OF THE STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY**


Student Satisfaction Survey on Teaching Learning process for 2022-2023 was conducted using

Google forms. There were 20 questions for which students should select the appropriate option and submit the feedback. Sufficient time was given to the students to submit the feedback.


The total number of students responded for this survey were 677 and comprised of BA, BCom, B.Sc, MA and MSc.






